

Easy Maintenance Fabrics

Culp Cantina, Archetype, Connelly,
Dwell, Haptic & Kudos

Spot clean only with water based upholstery shampoo or foam cleaner.

Pretest a small inconspicuous area before proceeding.

Do not over wet.

Do not use solvents to spot clean.

Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered.

To prevent overall soiling, frequent vacuuming or light brushing with a non-metallic, soft bristle brush to remove dust and grime is recommended.

When cleaning a spill, blot immediately to remove spilled material. Evenly clean the entire panel in a seam to seam fashion. Do not clean just the spots or stains.

Culp Dillon, Halyard, Linette & Lorna

A clean cloth, dampened with the appropriate cleaning solution, should be applied to the affected areas as soon as possible. Blot the fabric with the treated cloth, working from the outer edge of the stained area and moving in toward the center. In order to effectively draw out the stain, renew the cleaning cloth as often as necessary to maintain an absorbent surface.

Clean all stained areas as soon as possible in accordance with the recommended stain removal procedures. Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent, or mild dry cleaning solvent. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning is not a recommended cleaning method. Clean spots or stains from the outside to the middle of the affected area to prevent circling. (see Stain Removal Matrix below).

1. Soap and water
2. Difficult stains use Fantastik® or Formula 409®
3. Disinfects with 5:1 water / bleach solution

Sunbrella/Trivantage Blend, Heritage, & Nuance

Apply a light mist of mild soap and water using a spray bottle or use Sunbrella Clean Multi-Purpose Fabric Cleaner. You can also use an upholstery cleaner such as 303® Multi-Surface Cleaner.

Work the solution into the spill by lightly agitating the entire surface area of the fabric, moving from seam to seam, with a sponge or very soft bristle brush. Avoid scrubbing, and do not use a hard bristled brush or anything that will abrade the fabric.

Rinse the entire fabric thoroughly to remove all soap residue. Blot excess moisture with a clean, soft towel or sponge. Blot or wet-vacuum excess water from the entire surface area of the fabric, moving from seam to seam. Air dry. Repeat rinsing and blotting until all soap residue is removed

For oil based spills, apply an absorbent such as corn starch, then remove with a straight edge.
